

## East Pier Street

**Location:** East side of Pier St, between Murray and Hay Streets.

### Summary

- Most retail outlets and cafes have between one and five steps at their entrance
- Some cafés offer designated alfresco dining
- Two pick up/set down bays
- Wide pedestrian footpath

### Closest accessible parking:

- Pier street Car Park (CPP) (8 bays)

### Closest public transport:

- Red CAT stop 1 Pier Street
- Red CAT stop 13 Hay Street

**Pick up/set down bay:** Two set down bays on the east side of Pier St, one is on the opposite of Citro Restaurant and the other is at the corner of Pier St and Murray St, outside Aaron's Hotel.

### Closest accessible toilet:

- Pier Street Car Park (CPP) (6 bays)

**Signage:** Retail signage is generally easy to read.

**External Access:** Wide pedestrian footpath along both sides of Pier Street. Designated alfresco seating is located on the street side of the footpath. However café tables may encroach into the space adjacent to the building line.

**Retail:** Most shops and restaurants / cafes have between one and five steps at their entrance. Café 54 and Venezia have alfresco seating on the street side. Outdoor seats are shaded by umbrellas.
