

Fire Station Car Park

Location: Murray Street, opposite Royal Perth Hospital, near St Mary's Cathedral

Summary

- Open air car park
- Car park is located on a gentle slope, from Murray Street down to Hay Street
- Three accessible bays
- There is no accessible toilet on site

Vehicle access from: Hay Street (heading west) and Murray Street (heading east)

Pedestrian access to: Hay and Murray Streets

Opening hours: 24 hours

Cost per hour: \$1.60

Monday – Sunday \$9.70 for 10 hours parking

Monday – Friday \$7.80 for 10 hours parking commencing before 7:30am

Red CAT stop 2 Murray St

Red CAT stop 12 Hay St

Closest accessible toilet:

Pier Street Car Park (CPP) (6 bays)



Accessible bays:

Three bays

Each next to a ticket machine

3780mm wide

Level

The car park slopes down from Murray to Hay Street

Signage: There is no directional signage to the accessible bays. However, each bay is located next to a ticket machine and is indicated by elevated signage.

Pedestrian access to Hay Street: Paved footpath with a gentle gradient of 1:23.

Pedestrian access to Murray Street: Paved footpath with a gentle gradient of 1:23.

Parking Attendant: No attendant on site

Pay machines:

Three pay machines that can be easily identified.

Standing height

Height of operable component: 1460mm

Machines accept coins, notes and credit cards

Access to the pay machine is via a steep, narrow kerb ramp and a 1100mm wide path.
