Dear Residents and Business Owners

CITY OF PERTH COOL ROADS PROGRAM 2025/26

Reference is made to the notification letter issued on 27 February 2026 regarding the road closures associated with the City of Perth Cool Roads Program 2025/26. Due to unforeseen circumstances, a portion of Kings Park Avenue is now scheduled to be undertaken on Saturday, 21 March 2026. All other details contained in our previous letter remain unchanged. Please refer to the revised map attached on page 3 for further details regarding this change.

SCHEDULE OF WORKS

The City is planning to commence the works on Wednesday, 11 March 2026, with completion expected by Saturday, 21 March 2026, weather permitting. In the event of any unforeseen circumstances, the City may continue works up to and including Tuesday, 31 March 2026. The details are as below:

- **Preparation Works**

Preparation works are scheduled from Wednesday, 11 March to Friday, 13 March 2026, between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm. During this period, the road will remain open. However, some delays may be expected.

- **Sealing Works**

Road sealing works will be undertaken in accordance with the map with this letter. The map identifies the specific day on which each road, or section of a road, is scheduled to be sealed. Preliminary works will commence at 7:00 am. The relevant road or road section will be closed from 9:00 am on the scheduled sealing day and will remain closed until the seal has fully cured. It is anticipated that the works, including curing, will be completed before 7:00 pm.

Until the surface has properly cured and the road is formally reopened, **NO VEHICLES WILL BE PERMITTED TO DRIVE ON THE NEWLY SEALED SURFACE.**

Residents whose street, or section of street, will be closed for sealing works are permitted to park their vehicles, on the specific day they are affected, at any location along Park Avenue, Crawley Avenue, Wingfield Avenue, and Kings Park Avenue. Affected residents will be exempt from posted time restrictions at parking bays. However, they must comply with the conditions outlined below.

Residents must ensure that their vehicles are parked only within designated and clearly marked parking bays. They must also comply with all other parking restrictions, including, but not limited to, no-parking and no-stopping zones, bus zones, verges, and areas across driveways.

THIS ARRANGEMENT APPLIES ONLY TO RESIDENTS DIRECTLY AFFECTED BY THE ROAD CLOSURE FOR SEALING AND DOES NOT EXTEND TO THE WIDER AREA.

PROJECT IMPACTS

- It is essential that reticulation is not run on the day of sealing.
- Parking signs will be covered with “NO STOPPING” hoods in advance of the road closure day.
- To facilitate the contractor completing the works on time residents and businesses are advised not to leave vehicles within the work zone and in the hooded sections.
- Road closures will be in place to facilitate the works.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained during the work however delays should be expected.
- Noise from equipment during work hours can be expected.
