CP10.10 PARKING AND ACCESS TO COUNCIL HOUSE - COUNCILLORS

POLICY OBJECTIVE

To determine the arrangements for Councillors' parking and access in Council House.

POLICY STATEMENT

"One parking bay at Council House is reserved for each Elected Member to assist Members with the conduct of their duties." These bays are available for use only by Elected Members and are not transferable.

Access to the parking bays at all times and access to offices after normal office hours are restricted. Security coded keys are provided to Elected Members to use the car park and access the tenth floor outside normal office hours.

In accordance with City of Perth Parking Local Law 1999 Clause 6.9 "Councillor Parking Permit", Elected Members shall be provided with an Elected Member Parking Permit which will permit an Elected Member to park in all of the Council owned car parks and in the City's streets to enable the Member to carry out their duties or perform their functions as a Member of the Council.

The parking permit will exempt Councillors from Clauses 2.3(1)(d), 4.2(a), 4.2(b), 5.2(1)(a), 5.2(1)(b) and 5.3(b) of the Local Law provided that:-

- 1. the Councillor parking permit is displayed in the vehicle or affixed to the windscreen of the vehicle so as to be properly displayed;
- 2. the Councillor parking permit is valid;
- 3. the holder of the Councillor parking permit is carrying out his or her duties or performing his or her functions as a Member of the Council.
