## CP15.1 ERECTION OF SIGNS – SERVICE CLUBS

### POLICY OBJECTIVE

To define the conditions applicable to the erection of signs by service organisations on property of the Council.

### POLICY STATEMENT

The following conditions apply to the erection of signs on road verges and property of the Council:-

1. the service clubs known as Apex, Lions, Rotary or Jaycees may erect meeting signs on pylons at approved positions on the road verge;
2. similar applications received from like organisations should be dealt with on their respective merits;
3. the question of the degree of signage permissible shall be decided on an ad hoc basis;
4. installation and maintenance costs of the approved sign shall be borne by the respective Service Club / Organisation.
