## **CP20.12 CO-LOCATION OF POLES WITHIN ROAD RESERVE**

## **POLICY OBJECTIVE**

To identify, at the application or design stage, the opportunities that exist to co-locate street poles, thus reducing the proliferation of poles within the road reserve and improve the amenity and appearance of the street.

## **POLICY STATEMENT**

When applications are being assessed or designs are being considered that incorporate the installation of infrastructure requiring a street pole, the Council requires that the site be investigated with the view to co-locate the proposed infrastructure on an existing pole or relocate existing infrastructure onto the proposed pole before new poles will be approved.

In the case of an external application by a government agency or a private entity, the costs associated with these works will be met by the applicant.
