1	When to use this form	You may make a claim for eligibility using this form at any time. However if you want to be on the roll for a particular election you must give your claim form to the local government more than 50 days before the election date.	
2	Who should	You should fill in this form if you:	

use this form	 own or occupy³ rateable property in the City of Perth but are not on the residents roll in the City of Perth; or qualify under clause 12 of Schedule 9.3 to the <i>Local Government Act 1995</i>⁷,
	and want to be able to vote at local government elections for the City of Perth.

3 Who is an	To qualify as an occupier you must have a right, under a lease, tenancy	
occupier	agreement or other legal instrument, to be in continuous occupation of the	
	property for at least the next 3 months.	
	When the Chief Executive Officer of the local government is considering your	
	claim, he or she may ask you for a copy of your lease or tenancy agreement to	
	support your claim. You do not need to provide a copy unless asked.

	If a body corporate or group of people owns or occupies more than one property in a district, a nomination applies to all of those properties.
