Perth Town Hall opened in 1870, as a gift to the people of Perth from Governor Hampton. As Australia's only convict-built capital city town hall, it has proudly hosted gala events for prime ministers, princes and Nobel laureates. An award-winning restoration completed in 2005 returned this historical gem's original charm. At the same time, new air conditioning, sound and lighting systems enabled the Hall to meet the needs of today's growing city.
